**TITLE OF BILL:**

An act to amend the state law, in relation to establishing assembly and senate districts; and to repeal article 8 of such law relating thereto

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this bill is to establish 63 Senate districts and 150 Assembly districts.

**SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:**

This bill would:

- provide metes-and-bounds descriptions of 150 Assembly districts;
- provide metes-and-bounds descriptions of 63 Senate districts.

**EXISTING LAW:**

This bill would amend the New York State law to provide for the redistricting of the New York State Assembly and Senate.

**JUSTIFICATION:**

This bill establishes new legislative districts for the state Senate and Assembly. It is based on population figures from the 2020 Federal Census and population figures calculated in accordance with the Prisoner Allocation Law of 2010 (N.Y. Corr. L. § 71(8)). The districts comply with the United States and New York State Constitutions and the requirements of the Federal Voting Rights Act.

**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:**

**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the provisions of section four of this act shall take effect January 1, 2023.
